

TYPES OF BEQUESTS

When making your Will, it is important to seek advice from a solicitor.

The main types of bequests include:

- the residue the remainder of your estate after you have made provisions for family and other beneficiaries
- · a set percentage of your estate
- \cdot a set amount of money
- a specific asset e.g. property, shares, or other specific investments

For many donors, a percentage bequest is the most popular. This is because dividing your estate by percentage gives longevity to your Will as the gifts are not impacted by inflation or changes in the value or composition of your estate.





HOW DO I LEAVE A GIFT IN MY WILL TO THE FOOTSCRAY FOOTBALL CLUB LTD?

- 1. If you do not have a Will, you will need to contact a solicitor to create one. If you do have a Will, then you need to add a codicil a short legal amendment to your existing Will.
- 2. Decide on the type of bequest you would like to leave in your Will.
- 3. Discuss your intentions with your family so that your wishes outlined in your Will are fully understood.
- 4. Notify the Club to ensure we are aware of your intentions. Confidentiality is assured.
- 5. If you wish to nominate a specific area of the Club you would like to support, please contact the Club to discuss your wishes at bequests@westernbulldogs.com.au



UPDATING YOUR WILL

Making or revising a Will is neither difficult nor expensive. It is essential that you have a Will. Many people do not have one or their existing one is not updated. If you have already made your Will, you or your solicitor can easily add the Footscray Football Club Ltd through a short legal amendment known as a codicil.

It is recommended that you review your Will every couple of years as everyone's circumstances change and your Will should reflect your current wishes. As a starting point, we suggest talking to your family.

GOOD REASONS FOR UPDATING YOUR WILL

For many of us it may be some time since you last updated your Will. If any of these factors are relevant to you, they form a good reason to ensure your wishes are updated:

- · Death of a loved one
- · Illness, sickness or a health scare
- · Change of family circumstance e.g. marriage, separation, divorce
- · Travelling overseas or an extended holiday

CHANGING CIRCUMSTANCES

Should circumstances change after you have made a gift in your Will to the club and you need to amend it, then we do understand. We invite you to keep us informed along the way.



SUGGESTED WORDING FOR YOUR WILL

There is no obligation to give us a copy of your Will. We simply ask you to ensure both yours and your solicitor's details are recorded with the club. In most cases an exchange of letters with your solicitor is sufficient to ensure appropriate administration.
